Click on link  *Basket*  *Log in* (top right hand corner) and select **Athens Log-in**

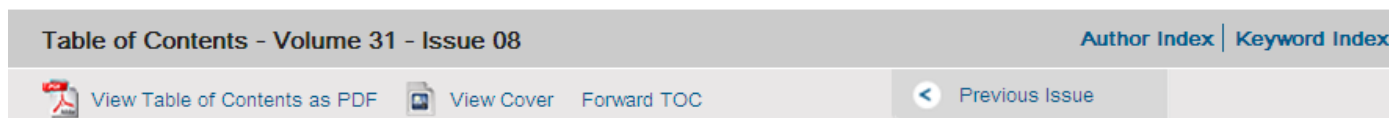


Type your SCIE Athens username and password


A number of the above options can also be selected using tabs

### **Using your search results**

Your search results can be browsed and articles of interest sorted (e.g by Title, Author, Article Type or Online Publication Date), then Viewed, Saved, Exported or Downloaded as a PDF.

For each article there is the option to preview, read the abstract, or view the full text as a PDF file or HTML. If you view the HTML the following options are available – Export Citation/ Citation/Save
